

***PUBLIC RECORD OF TRIBAL LANDS ASSESMENT  
June 2009 Update***

Since 2005, with funds awarded from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Brownfields State and Tribal Response Program, the Tribe's Natural Resources Department has been assessing Tribal properties for potential environmental hazards to determine if any need to be cleaned-up before they can be developed, or if they might need to be left undeveloped so as not to expose people to any danger.

A public record of these property assessments has been established and is available to the Tribal Community and members of the public in the Tribe's Library on the South Campus. This public record will remain in the Library and the records of all completed and future property assessments and/or clean-ups will be added to it. The Tribe's Library is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.
